# **Impact** Snapshot

Collaborative for Children Specialists trained and mentored 561 child care teachers and directors, and coached 9.539 parents and caregivers, reaching a total of 17,967 children. Of these, **3,470** were served through Centers of Excellence, and 8,329 through Collab-Lab and Collab Kid U.
