Encouraging social skills can be a good thing in the community as it builds confidence and promotes healthy relationships with others. Explore ways that you use to socialize with others and post them using the hashtag #grow2gether.

Children naturally are social beings if we let them. Sometimes it may take some introducing and connection before your child feels comfortable and confident to do so. We can help by enabling this with role modeling.

Invite your child to a conversation about getting familiar with those we see regularly. Ask questions such as, “What do you think our mail carrier does? Do you have questions for him or her? How about we say hello to him or her today?” Model social behavior that encourages your child to use it.

Letting your child be aware of his or her surroundings with the people that make up our community offers opportunities for involvement and a sense of security. The more you present opportunities to explore sharing moments with others, the more you help strengthen your child’s foundation in working alongside others productively.

- Does your child meet with other children in a group setting? Challenge your child to make a new friend by simply introducing him/herself or choosing to get to know someone a little better.
