



## Learning Languages

*Encouraging social interactions is a great way to help children learn about the world! How can we help foster curiosity of other cultures in our homes? Use your phone or computer to learn words in new languages and use #grow2gether to share with us.*

Our city is a very diverse place and learning about different cultures can help us be more understanding and accepting of our peers. An easy and fun way to learn about different cultures is to learn about their languages!

Work with your child to pick a common or useful word or phrase. Some examples you could start with are: “my name is \_\_\_\_.” “hello” “please”, “thank you”. Once you have chosen your word, use your phone or computer to search the word in a different language.

Try using your phrase or word throughout the day in the language that you chose for that day! Encourage your child to share what they have learned with their family and friends. Use this time to research and talk about the culture that uses the language that you chose!

- Check in with your neighbors. If they are from a different culture than you, they might be willing to share with you and your child about their culture.
