- Few or no trees in your yard? No worries. Take a trip to the gardening store with your child, pick out a tree to plant in the front or backyard.
- Planting garden soon? Great! Collect items that appear to be trash (i.e. egg shells, shredded paper, lint from dryer) to use a compost to help plants and flowers grow.
